We are half way through term one already and everyone is settling into school life in 2020. We have recently started focussing on self-management as there have been a number of belongings left lying around at school each day. We are encouraging all children to look after their own things and to take them with them when they leave or just to put them away appropriately. We can certainly use your support in this area and also ask you to keep naming everything that comes to school, especially items of clothing. There is a lost property container located under the front counter in Mrs Cormack's office. The first point of call for students though is in their classroom. Clothing only goes to the lost property when it is not named and has been unclaimed from the classroom.

It was fantastic to see so many parents coming along to share with us at our Whole School Assembly in the library last Friday. It is a rich opportunity for learners to be able to present some of the things they have been up to and to share some of their successes with you. Seesaw has had a reasonable uptake from our school community so far this year. If you have not enabled yours yet, or are having difficulty, then please get in touch with us for some help.

We conducted a lockdown drill last week. This will be one of many drills that we complete this year to be sure that we are well versed in what to do in the case of any emergency. Fire, earthquake and lockdown are the three main areas that we focus on. These are not meant to be frightening or intimidating for children in any way but are simply drills, for worst case scenarios, to keep us safe.

It is genuinely pleasing to see so many of our senior students accepting responsibility and going out of their way to ensure younger children are kept safe and know what is going on in the playground and around school. The value of manaakitanga (the process of showing kindness, generosity and care for others) is alive and well amongst our children. This is so important with so many students and new entrants joining our school community this year.

This week we farewell Miss Aimee Keenan who leaves us on maternity leave. She will be sorely missed by everyone but she has a worthy replacement in Mrs Jo Stanway. Jo has been here at Heriot before and will be familiar to many of you. We wish Aimee, Chris and Charlie all the very best over the coming months and we welcome Jo back into the fold.

All of the staff are working hard for your children but if there is anything that you question or would like to find out more about, then I urge you to contact me directly or talk to your child's classroom teacher.
